

Food and Drink at the Ridgefield Library

Enriching Minds. Enhancing Community. We are pleased to welcome the public to our beautiful Library. To keep it clean for all visitors, we have established the following guidelines:

Food may be consumed in the building <u>only</u> in the Bossidy Commons on the Main Level or on the Miller Terrace. There are benches and chairs for patrons outside on the lawn and the Lower Level Richardson Terrace for use, weather permitting.

Food is not permitted in Study Rooms, the Ellis Family Teen Center, the Randolph Board Room, the Lodewick Family Children's Library or other areas of the Library. This includes candy, chips and other snacks. Food may be permitted in the Lower Level program rooms during an event, with prior permission.

Beverages in closed containers are permitted in most areas of the Library, unless otherwise posted.

No beverages are allowed in the Donofrio Technology Center. In the event of a spill in the building, please notify Library staff immediately so appropriate clean-up can be done.

The Library does not maintain a café or vending machine. Water Fountains with bottle filling stations are available on each level.

We encourage visitors to patronize the many restaurants and other businesses in the downtown area that offer food and drink for on-site or take-out enjoyment. The Prospector Theater, adjacent to the Library, has a coffee bar on its premises.
